It was great to see our students competing in the broad variety of sports the School offers over the weekend. None more so than the Kayaking squad who competed in the Bendigo Cup ten-kilometre marathon. Captain of Kayaking, Jacob Hunting (Year 11), summarised the event, where many impressive results were recorded:

It was an early start for the kayakers that left for the Bendigo Cup on Saturday morning. Despite a slow start from most of the Camberwell boats, most made up any lost ground over the rest of the ten-kilometre race. The top four Camberwell boats formed a strong group that stayed together for most of the race, with Andrew Zhang (Year 11) and Bailey Stanley (Year 9) maintaining a firm lead for much of the race. The last kilometre was closely contested with Jacob Hunting (Year 11) and Rhys Campbell (Year 9), just making it out the front of the Camberwell boats in an almost photo finish; with a matter of metres between them and the first Trinity boat. The leading Camberwell boat came second in the Under 18 age group, behind Trinity, and the Camberwell team dominated most of the younger age groups. Congratulations to all the team who completed their first race of the season.

Round 2 this weekend sees the majority of our Firsts hosting their first home games for the season. First XI Cricket will feature on the Keith Anderson Oval for the first time since the Sports Complex redevelopment.

VTAC CourseSearch App

This year VCE students will be able to receive their ATAR and scaled study scores via two means. They can either logon to www.resultsandatar.vic.edu.au, using their VCE student number and results PIN (first four digits of their birthdate) or via the VTAC CourseSearch app. The app adds a "Login to your VTAC account" option to the main menu. Paid VTAC applicants will also receive a printed ATAR statement via the post.

VTAC Change of Preference

The change of preference option provides a safety net for Year 12 students to make realistic decisions based on their final results and to alter their preferences if they change their mind about which course to study. There is no cost involved in changing preferences; as long as the course application fee is paid, students can change their preferences as often as they like up until midday Wednesday 20 December.
